1 INTRODUCTION

- Government College of Engineering and Technology (GCET), Jammu was established in the year 1994 under the Department of Higher Education, Government of J&K. It is approved by AICTE, New Delhi and affiliated to University of Jammu, Jammu.
- GCET campus is spread over 869 Kanals of land at village Chak Bhalwal, Jammu. The college was established with the vision to provide valuable resources for industry and society through excellence in technical education and research.
- The College offers **PG Degree Courses (M.Tech)** in three engineering departments viz Electronics & Communication, Computer Science & Engineering and Mechanical Engineering with an intake capacity of 18 students each from the session 2020 onwards.
- The college also offers UG Degree courses (B.E.) in five disciplines in Electronics and Communication, Electrical, Computer, Mechanical and Civil Engineering with an intake capacity of 60 students in each program.
- Besides this, the college also offers Lateral Entry Scheme in B.E. 3rd Semester with an intake of 10% of the sanctioned intake capacity, supernumerary to the approved intake in each discipline of Engineering from Session 2015 onwards.
- GCET Jammu has become the first institution of UT of J&K to have its 03 UG programs accredited by **National Board of Accreditation (NBA)** in the year 2019. The programmes which have been accorded accreditation are as under:
 - o Computer Science & Engineering,
 - o Electronics & Communication Engineering
 - o Mechanical Engineering.
- The college is recognized by University Grants Commission under Section 2(f) and 12(b) of the UGC Act, 1956.
- The selection criteria for the students getting admission in:
 - PG program: through GATE/University of Jammu;
 - UG program: through CET conducted by J&K Board of Professional Entrance Examination (BOPEF)
- The Alumni of this Institution have excelled in various spheres and are positioned very well globally in a number of leading Government, Public Sector and Private Organizations at the UT and National level.

- The college is having highly qualified and experienced faculty recruited by open selection through J&K Public Service Commission. The Faculty members of this college are possessing requisite qualifications and experience in accordance with the AICTE norms and are providing consultancy /engineering solutions to various field agencies from time to time, in addition to performing their regular duties as per the academic curriculum. The faculty members are also engaged on an academic arrangement as per the requirement through selection committee formulated by the administrative department.
- GCET Jammu has availed **Technical Education Quality Improvement (TEQIP-III)**, a World Bank aided project of MHRD, GOI with an aim to enhance the quality of technical education.
- GCET has upgraded the existing lab infrastructure so as to develop the state of the art research facilities for the students/researchers in the field of engineering sciences.
- Further, to keep abreast with the latest technological happenings and demands of industry, the institute revises syllabus/course on regular basis besides providing opportunity to faculty/staff members and students to attend conferences/seminars/FDP/STC on the emerging areas at different IITS/IIMS etc. To enhance faculty competence, faculty/staff are also being deputed to the leading institutions in a phased manner to upgrade their qualification.
- Efforts are also being made to explore collaboration of this college with reputed institutions at National / International level/Industry of Repute and Research Centers for providing larger exposure to the students of the UT. In this direction, the institution has signed various MoU's with different organization/industries.
- For the welfare of students and staff, other academic and non-academic reforms are also being carried out for improving the learning outcomes from time to time. College conducts various crash courses in the campus for the benefit of the students, appearing in different competitive exams like GATE etc besides conducting workshops/courses on Communication Skills, Group Discussions, Personality Development, Career Counseling and aptitude test by hiring resource persons /experts from Industry & Government Institutions.
