MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

(MOU)

This **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING** (hereinafter called 'as the MOU) is entered into on 9th of the month of MARCH year 2021 and between

Centre for Invention, Innovation, Incubation and Training (CIIT)

Government Polytechnic College Jammu

Under the Directorate of Skill Development, Govt. of J&K

(Implementing Institution), represented by ER. ARUN BANGOTRA
Designation PRINCIPAL (hereafter referred to as 'Party 1') that expression shall, where the context so admits, be deemed to include its successors, executor and administrators of the Party 1

And

Government College of Engineering & Technology (GCET), Jammu

Institution represented by DR. SAMERU SHARMA
Designation PRINCIPAL (hereafter referred to as 'Party 2') which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include its successors in office, legal representatives and permitted assigns of the Party 2.

Preamble

WHEREAS this MoU is signed with a vision for up-skilling of the Engineering students of GCET by imparting the requisite knowledge and skills at CIIT facility Jammu, so as to bridge the gap between Industry & Academia and thereby enhance the employability of students.

1. Whereas Government Polytechnic College Jammu has established a Centre for Invention, Innovation, Incubation and Training (CIIT) for providing training in the latest trends of Manufacturing Technology, Automobile Engineering and other field of Engineering conforming to Industry 4.0, with the help of Tata Technologies Ltd Pune.
2. Whereas, in the true spirit of collaboration, both the parties i.e. Centre for Invention Innovation Incubation and Training, Government Polytechnic College Jammu (Party 1) and GCET, Jammu (Party 2) are desirous of collaborating with each other for the benefit of engineering students to enhance their skills and knowledge for better employability.
3. Whereas, this MOU defines the role and responsibilities of the participating parties, monitoring and other matters related to mutual collaboration /cooperation to foster the possibility of genuine and beneficial Skill Excellence.

Broad Objectives of the MOU

1. To bring around qualitative improvements through up-skilling in the areas of Manufacturing Technology, Automobile Engineering and other field of Engineering.
2. To increase the employability of the engineering students and support MSMEs and local industries through this CIIT.
3. To provide high-end, practical oriented industrial training to the students so as to enhance their employability.
4. To develop and adopt state of the art training curriculum to meet modern industrial practices.
5. To promote the idea of innovation, incubation and entrepreneurship amongst students so as to develop new products and technologies.
6. To promote technology start-ups.
7. To enhance the linkage between two institutes to conduct seminars, guest lectures, conferences for the benefit of students of both the institutes.



Now, the parties to this MOU hereby agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. Terms

- a) The MOU shall commence on the date the MOU is signed by both the parties.
- b) The MOU will be valid for 03 years from the date of signing this MOU.

2. Role of Centre for Invention Innovation Incubation and Training, GPC Jammu

- a) To provide necessary infrastructure like machines/tools/material etc. and human resources required for conducting such skill-based trainings.
- b) To assess and provide a certificate jointly with Tata Technologies to the students who successfully complete the course/internship and meet the specified criteria set by Tata Technologies.
- c) To include GCET students trained at CIIT, Govt. Polytechnic College Jammu, to be part of any employability event arranged by CIIT Jammu.
- d) To help in promoting the culture of invention, innovation and incubation among the students of GCET trained at CIIT, Govt. Polytechnic College Jammu for becoming future generation entrepreneurs.

- e) To design and conduct specific training programs for faculty and staff of GCET.

3. Role of Govt. College of Engineering & Technology, GCET Jammu

- a) To collaborate with CIIT in identifying the current skill gaps existing in the students in the area of Manufacturing Technology, Automobile Engineering and other field and thereby suggest the training curriculum to be adopted for bridging this gap.



- b) To depute students of GCET pursuing M. Tech and B. Tech. programs to CIIT Jammu in batches for conduction of their practical/industrial trainings/internships of varied duration.
 - c) To provide/arrange the fee of the students who will be trained at CIIT Jammu as per the prescribed norms of Party 1.
 - d) Both the parties shall endeavor to promote and support promotional activities to be undertaken by them in the area of skill development.
 - e) In the spirit of true collaboration, GCET will also offer to provide its lab facilities for up-skilling the students of Govt. Polytechnic College Jammu in new technology areas conforming to Industry 4.0, as and when desired by Party 1, on mutually agreed terms and conditions.
4. Understanding reached and agreed between Govt. College of Engineering and Technology, GCET and Centre for Invention Innovation Incubation and Training, Government Polytechnic College Jammu.

There shall be a coordination committee, which will include two members each nominated by both Party 1 and Party 2, to review the implementation of the MOU.

The committee shall:

- a) consider the addition/deletion of areas of coordination between the two parties.
- b) consider the continuance of the MOU beyond the expiry of MOU.





- c) monitor and review the progress of deliverables of this MOU in terms of training programs/workshops/Internships/Innovation & Incubation activities/start up activities.
- d) ensure that both parties intend to mutually cooperate in the first place and in good faith to accomplish the objectives of this MoU as and where stated. However, as set forth below, nothing in this MoU shall be construed as any type of legal or business contract and does not have any financial obligations on any of the parties.
- e) ensure that the party shall be excused and not be liable or responsible for any delay to perform services under this MoU to the extent that such delay or failure has arisen due to reasons not attributable to the party.

This MoU is binding on all parties and cannot be modified, amended, altered or supplemented except by MOU in writing signed by the duly authorized representative of all the parties.
